What is Software Center?

Microsoft Software Center is an application that allows you to select available software to download to your computer on-demand.


Please note: laptops need to be connected to wired/wireless **network** in order to use the Software Center.

Installing software


Below are instructions to help you install software automatically to your computer.

Launch Software Center

1. Go to **Start -> All Programs**




2. Click **Microsoft System Center** -> **Configuration Manager** -> **Software Center**



Install Software

After Software Center is launched, you will see a list of available applications. Click on the application to highlight it and then click the **"Install"** button in the bottom right corner to install the software.




You'll see the status changing from **"Available"** to **"Preparing download"** and then to **"Installing"**.

Click “**Next**” to proceed installation.



Click “**Install**” if Windows Security pops up.



Once the status shows "**Installed**", you can exit the Software Center and go to **Start -> Devices and Printers** to find the newly installed program.
